A Gypsy Mela was held on October 19th and the speaker was Sr. Prema who is a gypsy herself and her testimony was very powerful and touching. Her daughter Sr.Suvetha led in praise and worship and around 250 gypsies from different gypsy pockets were gathered to hear the testimony and were much encouraged to grow in God's Grace.

All the children were promoted this year, two girls Kauvery and Thillakavathy got into Diploma Nursing in Rainy Hospital, Chennai. Pandian has joined for a 6 month course (AC Mechanic) in RUSHA. The tuition classes in different centres are very beneficial as the parents are illiterate.7 girls are admitted in Rehoboth Hostel and four boys in Arul Yesu Illam, IMF, Thiruthani.
